Subject: - Vehicle Scrapping Policy - updation of scrapped vehicle on VAHAN portal - reggarding.

Madam / Sir,

I am directed to refer to the Ministry of Road Transport & Highways' (MoRTH) D.O. letter No. RT-23013/4/2021-T dated 24.12.2024 (copy enclosed) intimating thereby that the MoRTH has introduced the Voluntary Vehicle-Fleet Modernization Program (V-VMP), also known as the 'Vehicle Scrapping Policy' aimed at promoting an environment friendly ecosystem to place out unfit and polluting vehicles. The MoRT&H has, under the said policy, issued a notification [G.S.R.29 (E) dated 16.01.2023], which mandates the non-renewal of the Certificate of Registration for Government vehicles older than 15 years. Such vehicles must be scrapped exclusively at RVSFs. Further, it has been decided to prioritize scrapping of vehicles like ambulances, police department vehicles, fire brigade vehicles and SRTU buses that are older than 15 years.

2. It is also stated that, according to the VAHAN database, there are 1,506 Government-owned fire tenders and 7,185 police-owned vehicles (excluding impounded vehicles) that are older than 15 years. However, only 338 fire tenders have been scrapped and 10,275 police-owned vehicles

(including impounded vehicles) have already been scrapped. State-wise details of these vehicles are provided in the **Annexure**. It is observed that there may be cases where vehicles have already been de-registered or scrapped, but not updated in the VAHAN portal.

3. In view of the above, States/UTs are advised to initiate the scrapping of the remaining Government-owned vehicles older than 15 years at RVSFs and to update the VAHAN database immediately for successful implementation of the Policy of national importance.

The Ministry of Road Transport and Highways (MoRT&H) has introduced the Voluntary Vehicle-Fleet Modernization Program (V-VMP), also known as the 'Vehicle Scrapping Policy', aimed at promoting an environmentally friendly ecosystem to phase out unfit and polluting vehicles. As part of this initiative, a network of Registered Vehicle Scrapping Facilities (RVSFs) is being established across the country to ensure safe and eco-friendly disposal of these vehicles.

2. Under this Policy, the Ministry issued a notification (G.S.R. 29 (F) dated 16th January 2023), which mandates the non-renewal of the Certificate of Registration for Government vehicles older than 15 years. Such vehicles must be scrapped exclusively at Registered Vehicle Scrapping Facilities (RVSFs). Further, it has been decided to prioritize scrapping of vehicles like ambulances, police department vehicles, fire brigade vehicles, and SRTU buses that are older than 15 years.

3. According to the VAHAN database, there are 1,506 Government-owned fire tenders and 7,185 police-owned vehicles (excluding impounded vehicles) that are older than 15 years. However, only 338 fire tenders have been scrapped and 10,275 police-owned vehicles (including impounded vehicles) have already been scrapped. State-wise details of these vehicles are provided in the Annexure. It is observed that there may be cases where vehicles have already been de-registered or scrapped, but not updated in the VAHAN portal.

4. I request you to kindly direct the concerned State/Central departments to initiate the scrapping of the remaining Government-owned vehicles older than 15 years at RVSFs and to update the VAHAN database immediately for successful implementation of the Policy of national importance.
