In exercise of powers conferred by sub sections (2) and (4) of section 144 of the Himachal Pradesh Police Act, 2007 (Act No. 17 of 2007) read with section 20 and 23 of Himachal Pradesh General Clauses Act, 1968 (Act No. 24 of 1968), the Governor of Himachal Pradesh is pleased to make the following rules further to amend the Punjab Police Rules, 1934 in their application to the State of Himachal Pradesh, namely:-

Short title and commencement. 1. (1) These rules may be called the Punjab Police (Himachal Pradesh) First Amendment Rules, 2012.

(2) These rules shall come into force from the date of their publication in the Rajpatra, Himachal Pradesh.
