Integration of Examination Guidelines with Admits Cards for the Candidates:-

i. Test Structure

- The examination will consist of a **single composite paper of 3 hours duration**, comprising **two distinct sections: Paper-I: Carrying a total of 75 marks, and Paper-II: Also carrying 75 marks, making a combined total of 150 marks** for the entire examination.
- Each section will include **multiple-choice questions (MCQs)**, with the **entire test comprising 150 questions** in total. The questions will be **randomized and uniquely distributed per candidate** to maintain the integrity and fairness of the examination process.
- The syllabus for each section shall be as issued/circulated vide letter No. HOM(PL)AP&T(Trg)(C-1)(B-I Test) 06/2024-16804-844 dated 24-07/2025.
- Marking Scheme: Each correct answer will be awarded 01 mark.** There will be **no negative marking** for incorrect or unanswered questions, encouraging candidates to attempt all questions without the fear of penalty.

- Exam Time: 10:00 AM to 01:00 PM**
- Reporting Time: By 08:30 AM**
- Sitting in Exam Hall: By 09:30 AM**

iii. Second shift may be conducted:

Second Shift: 02:00 PM to 05:00 PM

Reporting: By 12:45 PM, Sitting in examination Hall: By 01:15 PM

iv. Mandatory Instructions

- Candidates shall appear in **proper Police Uniform**.
- Police Identity Card & Admit Card** is mandatory and must be carried to the exam venue.
- Each question will have the following attributes: Serial Number of Question, Hindi Text, Four Options, and the Correct Answer. For example:

- The software shall perform automatic randomization of questions for each candidate to ensure a unique test paper covering all subjects.
- The system will prompt candidates to confirm they have read the instructions by checking a box before they can proceed.
- After confirming they have read the instructions, the candidate can click the **"Start Exam"** button to initiate the exam.
- After the exam is completed/submitted by the candidates, the system will display the candidate's score immediately. The score will reflect the total number of questions answered, correct answers, and incorrect answers.
- An email shall be sent to the candidates, as well as user department as well as software development agency once the candidates have submitted their online test.
- Any discrepancy, technical issues, emergency or need of assistance, must be immediately reported to the center in-charge/supervisor Officer.
- After submitting the test, candidates will not be allowed to re-enter the hall.
- Candidates must keep their admit Card safely.
- Any candidate who has not appeared in the mock test shall also be eligible to appear in the final test. However, such a candidate will not have the right to claim that they were denied an opportunity to familiarize themselves with the online process of the B-I test.
