"O R D E R"

This appeal has been preferred by Sh. Roshan Lal S/o late Sh. Mohan Singh VPO Ratti Tehsil Balh District Mandi H.P.-175008 against the Public Information Officer-cum- Superintendent of Police, Welfare, PHQ, HP, Shimla letter dated 29.07.2025. This is the 1st appeal, filed by the appellant, received on 25.08.2025 to the undersigned.

The brief facts of the appeal/case are that the appellant has made complaint against his son namely Shri Chaman Lal regarding alleging unauthorized transactions from his Bank Accounts. The appellant has attached a copy of the intimation letter No. 16241 dated 19.07.2025 issued by the PIO, PHQ, however, the appellant has not sought any such information vide his above RTI appeal.

I have gone through the appeal of the appellant, and found that he has not sought any information vide his RTI appeal or it is not clear as what is the prayer of appellant vide his 1st RTI appeal.

I am of the opinion that a citizen has a right to seek such information from public authority which is held by the public authority or which is held under its control. In the instant matter, the Public Information Officer-cum-Superintendent of Police (Welfare) PHQ had informed to applicant within time vide letter dated 29.07.2025 as per RTI Act, 2005 and the RTI application was also transferred under section 6(3) of RTI Act, 2005 to the PIO O/o the Addl. Director General of Police, State CID, Shimla and PIO O/o the Superintendent of Police, Mandi District Mandi vide letter dated 22.07.2025. However, the aforesaid appeal which is a complaint nature has also been forwarded to Addl. SP, Cyber Crime, District Mandi (HP) for the conduct of discrete enquiry into the matter vide letter dated 16-09-2025.

The appeal is disposed of accordingly, keeping in view the principles of natural justice.

In case the appellant is not satisfied with this order, he may file an appeal within ninety days from the date on which the decision should have been or was actually received, before the 2nd Appellant Authority-cum-State Information Commission, Himachal Pradesh, Keonthal Commercial Complex, Khalini, Shimla-171002.
